**The Local Authorities (Armorial Bearings) Order 2006**

*Made - - - - 14th December 2006*

*Coming into force - - 15th December 2006*

At the Court at Buckingham Palace, the 14th day of December 2006

Present,

The Queen's Most Excellent Majesty in Council

Her Majesty, in exercise of the powers conferred upon Her by section 247 of the Local Government Act 1972<sup>(1)</sup>, is pleased, by and with the advice of Her Privy Council, to order as follows:

1. This Order may be cited as the Local Authorities (Armorial Bearings) Order 2006 and shall come into force on 15th December 2006.

2. The armorial bearings which, immediately before 1st April 1974, were borne and used by the corporation of the City of Canterbury may be borne and used by Canterbury City Council, provided they have first been exemplified according to the laws of arms and recorded in the College of Arms.
