TRANSITIONAL PROVISIONS IN RESPECT OF PERSONAL DENTAL SERVICES PROVIDED BEFORE 1ST APRIL 2006

Remuneration of pilot scheme providers

- **25.**—(1) Subject to paragraphs (2) and (3), claims for remuneration under the terms of a pilot scheme agreement may still be made and acceded to in accordance with a pilot scheme agreement, where a pilot scheme provider is entitled to a payment—
 - (a) under the agreement; or
- (b) as a consequence of the termination of the agreement, and the claim is made or deemed to have been made within any period stipulated in the pilot scheme
- agreement as being the period during which a claim for payment is to be made.

 (2) In a case where no period is specified for the making of a claim for payment in the pilot scheme agreement or a claim is made outside the specified period, the Primary Care Trust with which
- the pilot scheme provider was a party to the agreement (or, where appropriate, the NHS Business Services Authority acting on its behalf) may agree to determine such claims for a period up to six months from the date on which the circumstances which gave rise to the claim first arose.
- (3) This article is without prejudice to any arrangements for the recovery of dental charges set out in directions under sections 28E(3A) and 28N of the 1977 Act.
