TRANSITIONAL PROVISIONS AND SAVINGS

Offences of contravening a conservation notice

4.—(1) Subsection (4) of section 30 of the WRA (notices with respect to borings not requiring licences) continues to have effect in relation to any notice under section 30(2) of that Act given before the repeal of section 30 by virtue of section 8(3) and (5) of the Act.

(2) Subsections (2) and (4) of section 199 of the WRA⁽¹⁾ (notice etc. of mining operations which may affect water conservation) continue to have effect in relation to any notice under section 30(2) of that Act (as applied by section 199(2)) given before the coming into force of section 8(5) of the Act as they had effect immediately before the coming into force of that section.

(1) Section 199 of the WRA was amended by section 8(5) of the Act.
