The Lord Chancellor makes the following Regulations, in exercise of the powers conferred upon him by sections 58(3) and (4) and 65(1)(b) of the Mental Capacity Act 2005(1).

**Citation and commencement**

**1.** These Regulations may be cited as the Public Guardian (Fees, etc) (Amendment) Regulations 2007 and shall come into force on 1st October 2007.

**Amendment to the Public Guardian (Fees, etc) Regulations 2007**

**2.—(1)** Regulation 9 (exemptions) of the Public Guardian (Fees, etc) Regulations 2007(2) is amended as follows.

(2) In regulation 9(7)(b)(ii) omit the reference to “child”.
