- 9.—(1) Section 41(1) of the Environment Act 1995 (power to make schemes imposing charges)(1) is amended as follows—
 - (a) omit the word "and" at the end of Paragraph (c); and
 - (b) after Paragraph (d), insert—

"and

- (e) as a means of recovering costs incurred by it in performing functions conferred by Regulation (EC) No. 850/2004 of the European Parliament and of the Council on persistent organic pollutants and amending Directive 79/117/EEC as amended from time to time, each of the new Agencies may require the payment to it of such charges as may from time to time be prescribed;".
- (2) As a means of recovering costs incurred by it in performing functions conferred by Article 7(4)(b) of [F1Regulation (EU) 2019/1021]—
 - ^{F2}(a)
 - (b) in Northern Ireland the Department of [F3Agriculture, Environment and Rural Affairs] may charge the fee of £2,000.
 - (3) Fees must be paid by the applicant with the application.
