The Housing Act 2004 (Commencement No. 10) (England and Wales) Order 2007

Application of Part 5 of the Housing Act 2004 to residential properties with fewer than three bedrooms

- **3.**—(1) The types of property referred to in article 2 are—
 - (a) a residential property which—
 - (i) is physically complete at the first point of marketing; and
 - (ii) has fewer than three bedrooms;

and

- (b) a residential property which—
 - (i) is not physically complete at the first point of marketing; and
- (ii) is expected to have fewer than three bedrooms once physically complete, other than a property to the construction of which regulation 17C of the Building Regulations 2000(1) applies.
- (2) The duties under sections 155 to 159 of the Housing Act 2004 shall apply subject to the Home Information Pack (No.2) Regulations 2007(2).
