The Public Records (Technology Strategy Board) Order 2007

Her Majesty, in exercise of the powers conferred on Her by paragraph 3A of Schedule 1 to the Public Records Act 1958(1), is pleased, by and with the advice of Her Privy Council, to order, and it is ordered, as follows:

Citation and commencement

- 1.—(1) This Order may be cited as the Public Records (Technology Strategy Board) Order 2007
- (2) This Order comes into force on 1st February 2008.

Amendment to Schedule 1 to the Public Records Act 1958

2.—(1) Schedule 1 to the Public Records Act 1958 (definition of public records) is amended as follows.

- (2) In Part 2 of the Table at the end of paragraph 3, at the appropriate place insert—
“Technology Strategy Board.”.
