## The Approved European Pharmacy Qualifications Order of Council 2007

#### **PROSPECTIVE**

#### Citation, commencement and interpretation

- 1.—(1) This Order may be cited as the Approved European Pharmacy Qualifications Order of Council 2007 and shall come into force on 30th March 2007.
  - (2) In this Order—
    - "competent authorities", in relation to a relevant European State(1), means any authority or body designated by that relevant European State in accordance with the Pharmacy Qualifications Directive(2);
    - "the Pharmacy Training Directive" means Council Directive 85/432/EEC concerning the coordination of provisions laid down by law, regulation or administrative action in respect of certain activities in the field of pharmacy(3); and
    - "reference date", in relation to a relevant European State, means the date by which it was required to implement the Pharmacy Training Directive, and which is included in the second column of the table in Schedule 1 opposite the corresponding entry for that State in the first column.
