PUBLIC PASSENGER TRANSPORT

The Community Bus (Amendment) Regulations 2007

Made - - - - *6th March 2007*

Laid before Parliament *8th March 2007*

Coming into force - - *1st April 2007*

The Secretary of State for Transport makes the following Regulations in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 52(1) and 60(1)(e) of the Public Passenger Vehicles Act 1981(a) and section 126(1)(c) and 134 of the Transport Act 1985(b) and by virtue of the Department of Transport (Fees) Order 1988(c).

He has consulted with representative organisations in accordance with section 61(2) of the Public Passenger Vehicles Act 1981(d).

Citation and commencement

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Community Bus (Amendment) Regulations 2007 and shall come into force on 1st April 2007.

Amendments

2.—(1) The Community Bus Regulations 1986(e) are amended as follows.

(2) In regulation 4(1), for “£50” substitute “£53”.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Regulations)

These Regulations increase the fee for a community bus permit granted under section 22 of the Transport Act 1985 from £50 to £53 (an increase of 6%). The fee was last increased on 30th September 2005.
