# The Town and Country Planning (Control of Advertisements) (England) Regulations 2007

## PART 5 MISCELLANEOUS

### **Contravention of Regulations**

- **30.**—(1) Subject to paragraph (2), a person displaying an advertisement in contravention of these Regulations shall be liable, on summary conviction of an offence under section 224(3) of the Act, to a fine of an amount not exceeding level 4 on the standard scale(1) and, in the case of a continuing offence, one tenth of level 4 on the standard scale for each day during which the offence continues after conviction.
  - (2) Paragraph (1) does not apply to the Crown(2).
