**101.**—(1) In the Schedule to the Enterprise Act 2002 (Part 8 Notice to OFT of Intended Prosecution, Specified Enactments, Revocation and Transitional Provision) Order 2003 <sup>M1</sup> the table is amended as follows.

(2) In the entry in the column headed “Extent of Specification” in respect of the Consumer Protection Act 1987 <sup>M2</sup> omit “and all offences under Part III (misleading price indications)”.

(3) Omit the entry for the Fair Trading Act 1973 <sup>M3</sup>.

(4) Omit the entry for the Mock Auctions Act 1961 <sup>M4</sup>.

(5) After the entry for the Trade Marks Act 1994 <sup>M5</sup> insert—

“Consumer Protection from Unfair Trading All offences under those Regulations.”.

(6) In the entry in the column headed “Extent of Specification” in respect of the Weights and Measures Act 1985 <sup>M6</sup> omit “29 misrepresentation”.
