Citation, commencement and extent

4. The purposes referred to in article 3(1) are—
 - (a) the determination by an appeal tribunal constituted under Chapter 1 of Part 1 of the Social Security Act 1998⁽¹⁾ of an appeal which is referred to such a tribunal by the Scottish Ministers, or the Secretary of State on their behalf, pursuant to section 158 (appeal tribunals) of the Health and Social Care (Community Health and Standards) Act 2003⁽²⁾; and
 - (b) the determination by a Social Security Commissioner of an appeal made under section 159 (appeal to social security commissioner) of that Act against a decision falling within subparagraph (a).
