## The Companies Act 2006 (Consequential Amendments etc) Order 2008

## Savings for provisions relating to execution of documents

**8.**—(1) The repeal of provisions of Article 46A of the Companies (Northern Ireland) Order 1986(1) (execution of documents) does not affect the operation of that Article—

- (a) in relation to a liquidator of a company(2), or
- (b) as applied by the Foreign Companies (Execution of Documents) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 2003(3).

(2) That Article as so applied does not apply to companies registered in Great Britain to which section 44 of the Companies Act 2006 applies.
