

## SCHEDULE 3

### APPOINTMENTS

#### Applications for appointment

1.—(1) An application for appointment must be made in a manner approved by the GB competent authority.

(2) [<sup>F1</sup>Subject to sub-paragraph (2A), a fee] may be charged for, or in connection with, the consideration by, or on behalf of, the GB competent authority of an application for appointment.

[<sup>F2</sup>(2A) No fee may be charged for an appointment to which paragraph 2A applies.]

(3) Any fee charged must be reasonable for the work performed or to be performed.
