**The Electricity and Gas (Community  
Energy Saving Programme) Order 2009**

*Made - - - - 20th July 2009*

*Coming into force - - 1st September 2009*

The Secretary of State makes this Order in exercise of the powers conferred by section 33BC of the Gas Act 1986 <sup>M1</sup>, section 41A of the Electricity Act 1989 <sup>M2</sup> and section 103 of the Utilities Act 2000 <sup>M3</sup>.

The Secretary of State has consulted the Gas and Electricity Markets Authority, the National Consumer Council <sup>M4</sup>, electricity generators, electricity distributors, electricity suppliers, gas transporters, gas suppliers and such other persons as the Secretary of State considers appropriate.

A draft of this instrument has been approved by a resolution of each House of Parliament pursuant to section 33BC(12) of the Gas Act 1986, section 41A(12) of the Electricity Act 1989 and section 103(5) of the Utilities Act 2000.
