The Secretary of State makes this Order in exercise of the powers conferred by section 33BC of the Gas Act 1986^{M1}, section 41A of the Electricity Act 1989^{M2} and section 103 of the Utilities Act 2000^{M3}.

The Secretary of State has consulted the Gas and Electricity Markets Authority, the National Consumer Council ^{M4}, electricity generators, electricity distributors, electricity suppliers, gas transporters, gas suppliers and such other persons as the Secretary of State considers appropriate.

A draft of this instrument has been approved by a resolution of each House of Parliament pursuant to section 33BC(12) of the Gas Act 1986, section 41A(12) of the Electricity Act 1989 and section 103(5) of the Utilities Act 2000.
