**Saving for earlier consequential amendments, transitional provisions and savings**

**12.**—(1) Schedule 3 to this Order contains provisions preserving the effect of the provisions of <sup>F1</sup>... the Companies Consolidation (Consequential Provisions) (Northern Ireland) Order 1986 <sup>M1</sup> relating to old public companies.

- (2) The repeal of the other provisions of that <sup>F2</sup>... Order does not affect the operation of—
- (a) any provision amending an enactment that remains in force;
  - (b) any transitional provision that remains capable of having effect in relation to the corresponding provision of the Companies Act 2006;
  - (c) any saving that remains capable of having effect in relation to the repeal of an enactment by that <sup>F2</sup>... Order.
