ROAD TRAFFIC

**The A3 Trunk Road (Clay Lane and Stoke Road)
(Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2009**

Made - - - - *5th October 2009*
Coming into force - - *10th October 2009*

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A3 Trunk Road and connecting roads, is satisfied that traffic should be prohibited on some of those connecting roads because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the A3 Trunk Road (Clay Lane and Stoke Road) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2009 and shall come into force on 10th October 2009.

2. In this Order:

“the trunk road” means, the A3 Trunk Road (Guildford Bypass) in the County of Surrey;

“a slip road” means -

- (i) the road leading to the northbound carriageway of the trunk road from the A3100 (Clay Lane), or
- (ii) the road leading from the southbound carriageway of the trunk road to the A320 (Stoke Road);

“works” mean street lighting, illuminated sign cabling and associated works on the trunk road; and

“a works period” means a period of 8 hours starting at 2200 hours on Monday 12th October 2009 or on any subsequent day until 9th April 2011.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 4 below, no person shall, during a works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in a slip road.

4. Nothing in article 3 above shall apply to -

- (a) a vehicle being used in connection with the said works;
- (b) a vehicle being used for police, ambulance, fire and rescue authority or traffic officer purposes

- (c) a vehicle being used for police, ambulance, fire and rescue authority or traffic officer purposes;
- (d) anything done at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police officer or traffic officer in uniform; or
- (e) any vehicle being used for winter maintenance purposes.
