ROAD TRAFFIC

**The A2 Trunk Road
(Jubilee Way Bridge, Coastbound Carriageway)
(Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2009**

Made - - - - *26th October 2009*

Coming into force - - *31st October 2009*

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A2 Trunk Road, is satisfied that traffic should be prohibited on a length of that road because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the A2 Trunk Road (Jubilee Way Bridge, Coastbound Carriageway) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2009 and shall come into force on 31st October 2009.

2. In this Order:

“the trunk road” means the A2 Trunk Road near Dover in the County of Kent;

“the coastbound carriageway” means the coastbound carriageway of the trunk road (Jubilee Way) from its junction with the A258 near Guston to its junction with the A20 at Dover Eastern Docks;

“works” mean the installation of a de-icing system, weather station and associated works on the trunk road; and

“a works period” means a period of 10 hours starting at 2000 hours on Friday 6th November 2009 or on any subsequent Friday, Saturday or Sunday until 30th April 2011.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 4 below, no person shall, during a works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the coastbound carriageway.

4. The provisions of article 3 above shall apply only at such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs, and shall not apply to -

- (a) a vehicle being used in connection with the said works;
- (b) a vehicle being used for police, ambulance, fire and rescue authority or traffic officer purposes;
- (c) anything done at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police officer or traffic officer in uniform; or

(a) 1984 c.27; a new section 14 was substituted by the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991 (c.26), section 1(1) and Schedule 1.

(d) any vehicle being used for winter maintenance purposes.
