The Traffic Management (Transport for London) Permit Scheme Order 2009

Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as The Traffic Management (Transport for London) Permit Scheme Order 2009 and is to come into effect on 11th January 2010.

Interpretation

2. In this Order—

“the Transport for London Permit Scheme” means the permit scheme set out in the Schedule to this Order in terms commonly known as the “London Permit Scheme” which was prepared and submitted to the Secretary of State by Transport for London and has been approved by the Secretary of State; and

“specified streets” has the meaning given by regulation 8 of the Traffic Management Permit Scheme (England) Regulations 2007(1).

Commencement of Permit Scheme

3. The Transport for London Permit Scheme comes into effect on 11th January 2010.

Application of Part 8 of The Traffic Management Permit Scheme (England) Regulations 2007

4. Part 8 of the Traffic Management Permit Scheme (England) Regulations 2007 shall apply to the specified streets within the Transport for London Permit Scheme.
