**The M6 Motorway (Junction 19, Northbound and Southbound
Entry Slip Roads) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order
2009**

Made - - - - *7 December 2009*

Coming into force - - *13 December 2009*

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the M6 Motorway and slip roads, is satisfied that traffic on two of those slip roads in Cheshire East should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14 (1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 **(a)** and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order.

1. This Order may be cited as the M6 Motorway (Junction 19, Northbound and Southbound Entry Slip Roads) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2009 and shall come into force on 13 December 2009.

2. In this Order:

“the motorway” means the M6 Motorway at Junction 19;

“the first slip road” means the entry slip road leading to the northbound carriageway of the motorway;

“the second slip road” means the entry slip road leading to the southbound carriageway of the motorway;

“the works period” means periods over four nights during the following periods:

- i. overnight between 2100 hours and 0500 hours starting on Monday 14 December 2009 and ending on Thursday 24 December 2009;
- ii. starting at 0001 hours and ending at 0500 hours on Monday 4 January 2010; and

- iii. overnight between 2100 hours and 0500 hours starting on Monday 4 January 2010 and ending on Friday 19 February 2010.

Works may start and continue between the same times on subsequent nights, or continue until completed;

“Works” means the installation of crash cushions on the slip roads.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 4 of this Order, during the works period, no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the first and second slip roads.

4. The provisions of article 3 of this Order shall apply only at such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to any vehicle being used in connection with the works or by traffic officers, or for emergency purposes by the police, fire and rescue or ambulance services, or proceeding at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police officer or traffic officer in uniform.
