**The A500 Trunk Road (Stoke-on-Trent, Staffordshire)
(Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2009**

Made - - - - 2 December 2009

Coming into force - - 9 December 2009

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A500 Trunk Road (“the A500”) is satisfied that traffic on lengths of that road in the City of Stoke-on-Trent, in the County of Staffordshire should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the A500 Trunk Road (Stoke-on-Trent, Staffordshire) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2009 and shall come into force on 9 December 2009.

2. In this Order –

“the first length of trunk road” means the southbound carriageway of the A500 from its junction with the exit slip road leading to the A52/A5006 Interchange, to its junction with the entry slip road leading from the A52 City Road Interchange;

“the second length of trunk road” means the northbound carriageway of the A500 from its junction with the exit slip road leading to Whieldon Road, to its junction with the entry slip road leading from the A52/A5006 Interchange;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 5, no person shall, during the periods specified in the Schedule to this Order, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the first length of trunk road or the second length of trunk road.

4. Subject as mentioned in article 5, no person shall, during the periods specified in the Schedule to this Order, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in any slip road leading to the first length of trunk road or the second length of trunk road.

5. The provisions of articles 3 and 4 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to any vehicle -

- (a) being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes;
- (b) proceeding at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police constable in uniform; or
- (c) being used for or in connection with the said works.
