**The M66 Motorway Junction 4 (Southbound Link Road to the
M62 Motorway Eastbound) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic)
Order 2009**

Made - - - - - *21 December 2009*

Coming into force - - - - - *12 January 2010*

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the M66 and M62 Motorways and link roads is satisfied that traffic on one of those link roads in the District of Bury in Greater Manchester, should be prohibited because works are proposed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order:

1. This Order may be cited as The M66 Motorway Junction 4 (Southbound Link Road to the M62 Motorway Eastbound) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2009 and shall come into force on 12 January 2010.

2. In this Order:

"the link road" means the southbound link road from the M66 Motorway at Junction 4 to the M62 Motorway eastbound carriageway at Junction 18;

"the works period" means 2 periods overnight between 2200 hours and 0500 hours during a period starting on Wednesday 13 January 2010 and ending on Wednesday 20 January 2010;

However works may start and continue between the same times on subsequent nights, or continue until completed;

"works" means camera replacement works on the link road;

3. Subject as mentioned in article 4 of this Order no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any motor vehicle to enter or proceed in the link road.

4. The provisions of article 3 of this Order shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs, and shall not apply to:
- i) any vehicle being used for emergency purposes by the police, fire and rescue, or ambulance services;
 - ii) anything done at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police officer or traffic officer in uniform; or
 - iii) any vehicle being used in connection with the said works, or by traffic officers.
