ROAD TRAFFIC

The A46 Trunk Road (near Salford Priors, Warwickshire) (Temporary Restriction of Traffic) Order 2009

Made - - - - 28 December 2009

Coming into force - - 4 January 2010

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A46 Trunk Road (“the A46”) is satisfied that traffic on lengths of that trunk road near Salford Priors in the County of Warwickshire should be restricted because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order :-

1. This Order may be cited as The A46 Trunk Road (Near Salford Priors, Warwickshire) (Temporary Restriction of Traffic) Order 2009 and shall come into force on 4 January 2010.

2. In this Order –

“the first length of trunk road” means the northbound carriageway of the A46 from a point 500 metres south of its roundabout junction with the B439 Salford Road and Station Road, to that roundabout;

“the second length of trunk road” means the northbound carriageway of the A46 from its roundabout junction with the B439 Salford Road and Station Road, in a northerly direction for a distance of 3000 metres;

"the works period" means the period starting at 20:00 hours on Monday 11 January 2010 and ending when the said works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 5, no person shall, during the works period, drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 40 miles per hour on the first length of trunk road or the second length of trunk road.

4. Subject as mentioned in article 5, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to be driven at a speed exceeding 10 miles per hour on the first length of trunk road or the second length of trunk road whilst traffic signs of a character authorised under section 64 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 indicating “convoy working” on those lengths of road are displayed.

5. The provisions of articles 3 and 4 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to any vehicle being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes.
