## ROAD TRAFFIC

# The A49 Trunk Road (Harewood End, Herefordshire) (Temporary 10 Miles Per Hour and 40 Miles Per Hour Speed Restriction) Order 2009 

Made - - - - 28 December 2009<br>Coming into force - - 4 January 2010

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A49 Trunk Road ("the A49"), is satisfied that traffic on a length of that road at Harewood End in the District of the County of Herefordshire should be restricted because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the A49 Trunk Road (Harewood End, Herefordshire) (Temporary 10 Miles Per Hour and 40 Miles Per Hour Speed Restriction) Order 2009 and shall come into force on 4 January 2010.
2. In this Order -
"the trunk road" means the A49 from a point 200 metres south of its junction with the A4137 to its junction with the B4348;
"the works period" means the period starting at 20.00 hours on Monday 11 January 2010 and ending when the said works have been completed;
and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.
3. Subject as mentioned in article 4, no person shall, during the works period, drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding -
(a) 10 miles per hour on a length of the trunk road whilst traffic signs of a character authorised under section 64 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 indicating "convoy working" on that length of road are displayed; or
(b) 40 miles per hour on a length of the trunk road whilst such traffic signs in relation to that length are not displayed.

4. The provisions of article 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs, and shall not apply to any vehicle -
(a) being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes; or
(b) proceeding at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police constable in uniform.
