The Amber Valley (Related Alterations) Order 2009

Made - - - - *6th March 2009*

Coming into force in accordance with article 1(2) and (3)

Under section 9(6) of the Local Government and Rating Act 1997^(a) ('the 1997 Act') Amber Valley Borough Council^(b) made proposals to the Electoral Commission for the related alteration of the boundaries of county electoral divisions and district wards within the Council's area.

The Electoral Commission have decided to give effect to the proposals and in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1A) of the 1997 Act^(c) make the following Order:

Citation and commencement

- 1.—(1) This Order may be cited as the Amber Valley (Related Alterations) Order 2009.
- (2) This Order, with the exception of article 4, comes into force—
 - (a) for the purpose of proceedings preliminary or relating to the election of councillors for a county electoral division, on the day after that on which the Order is made;
 - (b) for all other purposes, on the ordinary day of election of councillors in 2009.
- (3) Article 4 comes into force—
 - (a) for the purpose of proceedings preliminary or relating to the election of councillors for a district electoral division, on 15th October 2009;
 - (b) for all other purposes, on the ordinary day of election of councillors in 2010.

Interpretation

2. In this Order—

“ordinary day of election of councillors” has the meaning given by section 37 of the Representation of the People Act 1983(a);

“the 2003 Order” means the Amber Valley (Parishes) Order 2003.

Related alterations of county electoral division boundaries

3.—(1) Each area that ceased to be part of the parish of Belper and became part of the parish of Holbrook in consequence of the 2003 Order ceases to be part of the Duffield and Belper South county electoral division and becomes part of the Horsley county electoral division.

(2) In this article “county electoral division” means an electoral division established by the County of Derbyshire (Electoral Changes) Order 2004(b).

Related alterations of district ward boundaries

4.—(1) Each area described in column 1 of the Table in the Schedule to this Order ceases to be part of the district ward named in column 2 of the Table, and becomes part of the district ward named in column 3 of the Table.

(2) In this article “district ward” means a ward established by the Borough of Amber Valley (Electoral Changes) Order 1999(c).

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Order)

This Order gives effect to proposals made by Amber Valley Borough Council to the Electoral Commission for related alterations of the boundaries of county electoral divisions and district (borough) wards. These alterations are related to changes to the boundaries of parishes made by the Amber Valley (Parishes) Order 2003.

The new boundaries apply in respect of county elections to be held on and after the ordinary day of election of councillors in 2009 and borough elections to be held on and after the ordinary day of election of councillors in 2010.

Article 3 makes alterations to the boundaries of Duffield and Belper South, and Horsley county electoral divisions.

Article 4 makes alterations to the boundaries of Belper South, Duffield, Heanor East, Kilburn, Denby and Holbrook, and Shipley Park, Horsley and Horsley Woodhouse borough wards.
