ROAD TRAFFIC

**The A38 Trunk Road (Junction with the A5148, Staffordshire)
(Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2010**

Made - - - 30 April 2010

Coming into force - - 7 May 2010

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A38 Trunk Road (“the A38”), is satisfied that traffic on a length of that road, south of Lichfield in the County of Staffordshire should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (a), and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the A38 Trunk Road (Junction with the A5148, Staffordshire) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2010 and shall come into force on 7 May 2010.

2. In this Order –

“the trunk road” means the southbound carriageway of the A38 from its junction with the slip road leading to its roundabout junction with the A5148 and A5026 to its junction with the A5148;

“the works period” means the period starting at 22.00 hours on Monday 10 May 2010 and ending when the said works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 4, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the trunk road.

4. The provisions of article 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to any vehicle-

(a) being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes;

- (b) proceeding at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police constable; or
- (c) being used in connection with the said works.
