ROAD TRAFFIC

The M60 Motorway (Junction 3, Anticlockwise Entry Slip Road from A34 Northbound) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2010

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the M60 Motorway and its slip roads, is satisfied that traffic on one of those slip roads in the Borough of Stockport in Greater Manchester should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14 (1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (a), hereby makes the following Order.

1. This Order may be cited as the M60 Motorway (Junction 3, Anticlockwise Entry Slip Road from A34 Northbound) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2010 and shall come into force on 15 July 2010.

2. In this Order;

"the slip road" means the entry slip road leading to the anticlockwise carriageway of the M60 Motorway at Junction 3 from the A34 northbound;

"works" means anti-skid and road marking works on the slip road;

"the works period" means four nights between 2200 hours and 0500 hours during a period starting on Friday 16 July 2010 and ending on Monday 26 July 2010. However, work may start and continue between the same times on subsequent nights or continue overnight until completed, for such further period not exceeding 18 months as shall be required to complete the work.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 4 of this Order, during the works period, no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the slip road.

4. The provisions of article 3 of this Order shall apply only at such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to any vehicle being used for emergency purposes by the police, fire and rescue or ambulance services, vehicles being used in connection with the works, or by traffic officers, or to any vehicle proceeding at the direction, or with the permission, of a constable, or a traffic officer in uniform.
