The Local Land Charges (Amendment) Rules 2010

Made - - - - 12th July 2010

Laid before Parliament 27th July 2010

Coming into force in accordance with rule 1

The Lord Chancellor, in exercise of the power conferred by section 14 of the Local Land Charges Act 1975⁽¹⁾ and with the concurrence of the Treasury, makes the following Rules:

Citation and commencement

1. These Rules may be cited as the Local Land Charges (Amendment) Rules 2010 and come into force 21 days after the date they are laid before Parliament.

Amendment to the Local Land Charges Rules 1977

2. In Schedule 3 (fees) to the Local Land Charges Rules 1977⁽²⁾, item 5 (personal search in the whole or in part of the register) is omitted.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Rules)

These Rules amend the Local Land Charges Rules 1977 ([SI 1977/985](#)) by removing from Schedule 3 (fees) the whole of the entry for item 5 (personal search in the whole or in part of the register in respect of one parcel of land or, where the search extends to more than one parcel, those parcels). The fee is incompatible with the Environmental Information Regulations 2004⁽³⁾ which implement Council Directive [2003/4/EC](#)⁽⁴⁾ on public access to environmental information.
