ROAD TRAFFIC

The A282 and A2 Trunk Roads and the M25 Motorway (Junctions 1A - 2) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2010

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A282 Trunk Road, the A2 Trunk Road, the M25 Motorway and connecting roads, is satisfied that traffic should be prohibited on some of those connecting roads because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act $1984(\mathbf{a})$, hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the A282 and A2 Trunk Roads and the M25 Motorway (Junctions 1A - 2) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2010 and shall come into force on 24th July 2010.

2. In this Order:

"the A282", "the A2" and "the M25" mean, respectively, the A282 Trunk Road, the A2 Trunk Road and the M25 Motorway in the County of Kent;

"a slip road" means -

- (i) the road leading from the northbound carriageway of the A282 to the A206 (University Way) at Junction 1A,
- (ii) the road leading from the A206/B3228 to the southbound carriageway of the A282 at Junction 1A,
- (iii) the road leading from the southbound carriageway of the A282 to the A206/B3228 at Junction 1A,
- (iv) the road leading from the southbound carriageway of the A282 to the A296 at Junction 1B,
- (v) the road leading to the westbound carriageway of the A2 at M25 Junction 2 (A282) at Darenth Interchange, or
- (vi) the road leading from the anti-clockwise carriageway of the M25 at Junction 2 at Darenth Interchange (A282/A2);

"the westbound carriageway" means the westbound carriageway of the A282 overbridge at Junction 1A (A206);

"works" mean resurfacing and road marking work on the A282, the A2 and the M25; and "a works period" means a period of -

- (i) 7¹/₂ hours starting at 2200 hours on Monday 26th July 2010 or on any subsequent day other than a Friday, Saturday or Sunday,
- (ii) 7 hours starting at 2300 hours on Friday 30th July 2010 or on any subsequent Friday,
- (iii) 8 hours starting at 2200 hours on Saturday 31st July 2010 or on any subsequent Saturday, or
- (iv) 7 hours starting at 2230 hours on Sunday 1st August 2010 or on any subsequent Sunday,

until 23rd January 2012.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 4 below, no person shall, during a works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in a slip road or the westbound carriageway.

4. The provisions of article 3 above shall apply only at such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs, and shall not apply to -

- (a) a vehicle being used in connection with the said works;
- (b) a vehicle being used for police, ambulance, traffic officer or fire and rescue authority purposes;
- (c) anything done at the direction of, or with the permission of, a constable or traffic officer in uniform; or
- (d) any vehicle being used for winter maintenance purposes.
