**ROAD TRAFFIC**

**The A38 Trunk Road (Island Shop Junction, Liskeard, to  
Trerulefoot Roundabout, Cornwall) (Temporary Prohibition of  
Traffic) Order 2010**

<i>Made</i>	- - - -	<i>20 July 2010</i>
<i>Coming into force</i>	- -	<i>24 July 2010</i>

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A38 Trunk Road (“the A38”), is satisfied that traffic on lengths of that road between Liskeard and the Trerulefoot Roundabout in Cornwall should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the A38 Trunk Road (Island Shop Junction, Liskeard, to Trerulefoot Roundabout, Cornwall) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2010 and shall come into force on 24 July 2010.

2. In this Order –

“the first length of the A38” means the eastbound carriageway of the A38 from the tip of the nosing of the eastbound exit slip road at the Island Shop Junction, Liskeard, to the western edge of the Trerulefoot Roundabout;

“the second length of the A38” means the westbound carriageway of the A38 from the western edge of the Trerulefoot Roundabout to its junction with the B3252 at the Looe Lane End Junction;

“tip of the nosing” means the last point where an exit slip road leaves the carriageway of a trunk road;

“the works” mean road stud replacement and carriageway repair works;

“a works period” means a period of 10 hours starting at 20.00 hours on Monday 26 July 2010 or any subsequent day and ending when the said works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 4, no person shall, during a works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the first length of the A38 and / or the second length of the A38.

4. The provisions of article 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to:

(a) a vehicle being used for police, traffic officer, fire and rescue authority or ambulance purposes;

(b) anything done at the direction of, or with the permission of, a constable or traffic officer in uniform;

(c) a vehicle being used for or in connection with the said works.
