ROAD TRAFFIC

The A3 Trunk Road (Longmoor Interchange – Ham Barn Roundabout, Southbound) (Temporary Restriction of Traffic) Order 2010

Made - - - - *19th July 2010*

Coming into force - - *24th July 2010*

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A3 Trunk Road, is satisfied that traffic should be restricted on a length of that road because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the A3 Trunk Road (Longmoor Interchange – Ham Barn Roundabout) (Temporary Restriction of Traffic) Order 2010 and shall come into force on 24th July 2010.

2. In this Order:

“the trunk road” means the A3 Trunk Road in the County of Hampshire;

“the southbound carriageway” means the southbound carriageway of the trunk road between the slip road leading from that carriageway at Longmoor Interchange (A325 - Woolmer Road) and Ham Barn roundabout (B3006);

“works” mean carriageway repairs and highway maintenance work on the trunk road; and

“a works period” means a period of 7½ hours starting at 2200 hours on Wednesday 28th July 2010 or on any subsequent day until 23rd January 2012.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 5 below, no person shall, during a works period, cause or permit any vehicle to overtake any other moving vehicle on the southbound carriageway.

4. Subject as mentioned in article 5 below, no person shall, during a works period, drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding –

(a) 10 miles per hour on the southbound carriageway while traffic signs of a character authorised under section 64 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 indicating “convoy working” on that length of road are displayed; or

(b) 40 miles per hour on the southbound carriageway while the traffic signs specified in paragraph (a) of this article in relation to that length of road are not displayed.

5. The provisions of articles 3 and 4 above shall apply only at such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs, and shall not apply to a vehicle being used for police, ambulance or fire and rescue authority purposes.
