ROAD TRAFFIC

The A3 Trunk Road (Longmoor Interchange – Ham Barn Roundabout, Southbound) (Temporary Restriction of Traffic)
Order 2010

Made - - - - 19th July 2010

Coming into force - - 24th July 2010

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A3 Trunk Road, is satisfied that traffic should be restricted on a length of that road because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the A3 Trunk Road (Longmoor Interchange – Ham Barn Roundabout) (Temporary Restriction of Traffic) Order 2010 and shall come into force on 24th July 2010.

2. In this Order:

"the trunk road" means the A3 Trunk Road in the County of Hampshire;

"the southbound carriageway" means the southbound carriageway of the trunk road between the slip road leading from that carriageway at Longmoor Interchange (A325 - Woolmer Road) and Ham Barn roundabout (B3006);

"works" mean carriageway repairs and highway maintenance work on the trunk road; and

- "a works period" means a period of $7\frac{1}{2}$ hours starting at 2200 hours on Wednesday 28th July 2010 or on any subsequent day until 23rd January 2012.
- **3.** Subject as mentioned in article 5 below, no person shall, during a works period, cause or permit any vehicle to overtake any other moving vehicle on the southbound carriageway.
- **4.** Subject as mentioned in article 5 below, no person shall, during a works period, drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding
 - (a) 10 miles per hour on the southbound carriageway while traffic signs of a character authorised under section 64 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 indicating "convoy working" on that length of road are displayed; or
 - (b) 40 miles per hour on the southbound carriageway while the traffic signs specified in paragraph (a) of this article in relation to that length of road are not displayed.
- **5.** The provisions of articles 3 and 4 above shall apply only at such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs, and shall not apply to a vehicle being used for police, ambulance or fire and rescue authority purposes.
