

## SCHEDULE 2

### Consequential amendments to primary legislation

#### Companies Act 1989

9. In Section 87(2) of the Companies Act 1989<sup>(1)</sup> (exceptions from restrictions on disclosure)—
- (a) for paragraph (b) substitute—
    - “(b) civil proceedings arising under or by virtue of the Financial Services and Markets Act 2000 and proceedings before the Upper Tribunal in respect of—
      - (i) a decision of the Financial Services Authority;
      - (ii) a decision of the Bank of England; or
      - (iii) a decision of a person relating to the assessment of any compensation or consideration under the Banking (Special Provisions) Act 2008<sup>(2)</sup> or the Banking Act 2009<sup>(3)</sup>,”; and
  - (b) in paragraph (d) for “the Pensions Regulator Tribunal” substitute “a tribunal in relation to a decision of the Pensions Regulator”.
