Amendment of the National Health Service (Tribunal) (Scotland) Regulations 2004

39. In regulation 2(1) of the National Health Service (Tribunal) (Scotland) Regulations 2004(1) (interpretation and forms)—

(a) for the definition of “pharmacist” substitute—

““pharmacist” means a registered pharmacist within the meaning of article 3(1) of the Pharmacy Order 2010;” and

(b) for paragraph (d) of the definition of “relevant professional body” substitute—

“(d) in relation to a practitioner who is a pharmacist, the General Pharmaceutical Council;”.
