**The Protection of Vulnerable Groups (Scotland)
Act 2007 (Consequential Provisions) Order 2010**

PART 1

Introduction

Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Protection of Vulnerable Groups (Scotland) Act 2007 (Consequential Provisions) Order 2010 and comes into force on the same day as section 1 of Protection of Vulnerable Groups (Scotland) Act 2007⁽¹⁾.

Interpretation

2. In this Order—

“the 2006 Act” means the Safeguarding Vulnerable Groups Act 2006⁽²⁾;

“the 2007 Act” means the Protection of Vulnerable Groups (Scotland) Act 2007;

“Independent Safeguarding Authority” and “ISA” mean the body established by section 1 of the 2006 Act⁽³⁾;

“the 2007 Order” means the Safeguarding Vulnerable Groups (Northern Ireland) Order 2007⁽⁴⁾; and

“police force” means—

- (a) a police force in England and Wales;
- (b) the Police Service of Northern Ireland;
- (c) the Royal Navy Police;
- (d) the Royal Military Police;
- (e) the Royal Air Force Police;
- (f) the Ministry of Defence Police;
- (g) the British Transport Police;
- (h) the Civil Nuclear Constabulary;
- (i) the Serious Organised Crime Agency;
- (j) the Child Exploitation and Online Protection Centre; and
- (k) in article 3(1) also includes—

(1) 2007 asp 14.

(3) The Independent Barring Board (IBB) established by the Safeguarding Vulnerable Groups Act 2006 (c.47) was renamed the Independent Safeguarding Authority (ISA) by section 81(1) of the Policing and Crime Act 2009 (c.26).
