**The Immigration (Designation of  
Travel Bans) (Amendment) Order 2010**

The Secretary of State makes the following Order in exercise of the powers conferred by section 8B(5) of the Immigration Act 1971<sup>(1)</sup>:

1. This Order may be cited as the Immigration (Designation of Travel Bans) (Amendment) Order 2010 and shall come into force on 20th December 2010.
2. For the Schedule to the Immigration (Designation of Travel Bans) Order 2000<sup>(2)</sup> substitute the Schedule set out in the Schedule to this Order.
3. The Immigration (Designation of Travel Bans) (Amendment) Order 2009<sup>(3)</sup> is revoked.

2009 (“the 2009 Order”). Any person named by or under an instrument listed in the new Schedule or falling within a description in such an instrument will be excluded from the United Kingdom (subject to the exceptions specified in article 3 of the 2000 Order).

The effect of substituting the Schedule set out in the Schedule to this Order for the Schedule to the 2000 Order is to add to and delete from, the list of designated instruments, and to make some amendments to the list.
