**Further conviction in magistrates' court after sentence deferred**

**45.1.** Where under section 1 of the Powers of Criminal Courts (Sentencing) Act 2000<sup>(1)</sup> a court has deferred passing sentence on an offender and before the expiration of the period of deferment he is convicted of any offence by a magistrates' court, the court officer for the convicting court shall, if the court which deferred passing sentence on the earlier occasion was another magistrates' court or the Crown Court, give notice of the conviction to the court officer for that court.
