ROAD TRAFFIC

The M6 Motorway (Junction 2, Near Coventry) (Temporary Restriction of Traffic) Order 2010

Made - - - - 15 February 2010

Coming into force - - 22 February 2010

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the M6 Motorway ("the M6") and connecting roads, is satisfied that traffic on lengths of that motorway and on two of those connecting roads in the City of Coventry and in the County of Warwickshire should be restricted because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14 (1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the M6 Motorway (Junction 2, Near Coventry) (Temporary Restriction of Traffic) Order 2010 and shall come into force on 22 February 2010.

2. In this Order -

"the first length of motorway" means the southbound carriageway of the M6 between

points 1800 metres north and 590 metres south of the

centrepoint of Woodway Lane Footbridge;

"the second length of motorway" means the northbound carriageway of the M6 from a

point 2510 metres south of the M69 overbridge at Junction 2, to a point 400 metres north of the centrepoint

of Woodway Lane Footbridge;

"the link road" means the link road leading from the southbound

carriageway of the M69 to the northbound carriageway of

the M6;

"the slip road" means the slip road leading to the northbound

carriageway of the M6 at Junction 2;

"the works period" means the period starting at 22.00 hours on Monday 1

March 2010 and ending when the said works have been

completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.
