ELECTRICITY

The Electricity (Standards of Performance) Regulations 2010

Made - - - - *8th March 2010*

Coming into force - - *1st April 2010*

The Gas and Electricity Markets Authority⁽¹⁾ (the “Authority”) makes the following Regulations in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 39, 39A, 39B, 42A and 60 of the Electricity Act 1989⁽²⁾;

In accordance with section 40B(1) of that Act, the Authority has considered the results of research to discover the views of a representative sample of persons likely to be affected by these Regulations;

In accordance with section 40B(4) of that Act, the Authority has consulted the National Consumer Council⁽³⁾, electricity licence holders, and persons and bodies appearing to be representative of persons likely to be affected by these Regulations;

The Secretary of State has consented to making these Regulations in accordance with sections 39(1), 39A(1) and 39B(3) and (5) of that Act.
