Consequential amendments in relation to public health protection

Public Health (Ships) Regulations 1979

1. In the Public Health (Ships) Regulations 1979⁽¹⁾, in regulation 2(1) (interpretation), in sub-paragraph (b) of the definition of “local authority”—

(a) at the end of paragraph (iii), omit “or”; and

(b) for paragraph (iv), substitute the following paragraphs—

“(iv) the Common Council of the City of London,

(v) the Sub-Treasurer of the Inner Temple and the Under Treasurer of the Middle Temple, or

(vi) the Council of the Isles of Scilly;”.

Public Health (International Trains) Regulations 1994

2. In the Public Health (International Trains) Regulations 1994⁽²⁾, in regulation 2(1) (interpretation), omit the definition of “viral haemorrhagic fever”.

Immigration (European Economic Area) Regulations 2006

3. In the Immigration (European Economic Area) Regulations 2006⁽³⁾, in regulation 21(7) (decisions taken on public policy, public security and public health grounds), in sub-paragraph (a), for “to which section 38 of the Public Health (Control of Disease) Act 1984 applies (detention in hospital of a person with a notifiable disease)” substitute “listed in Schedule 1 to the Health Protection (Notification) Regulations 2010⁽⁴⁾”.
