The Secretary of State in the exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 2(2) of the European Communities Act 1972<sup>(1)</sup> and by sections 7, 272(7) and 273(4) of the National Health Service Act 2006<sup>(2)</sup>, makes the following Regulations.

The Secretary of State is a Minister designated for the purposes of section 2(2) of the European Communities Act 1972 in relation to the National Health Service<sup>(3)</sup>.
