The National Health Service (Reimbursement of the Cost of EEA Treatment) Regulations 2010

The Secretary of State in the exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 2(2) of the European Communities Act 1972(1) and by sections 7, 272(7) and 273(4) of the National Health Service Act 2006(2), makes the following Regulations.

The Secretary of State is a Minister designated for the purposes of section 2(2) of the European Communities Act 1972 in relation to the National Health Service(**3**).
