**SOCIAL SECURITY**

**The Employment and Support Allowance  
(Work-Related Activity) Regulations 2011**

*Made* - - - - - *26th May 2011*

*Coming into force* - - - - - *1st June 2011*

In accordance with section 26(1)(b) of the Welfare Reform Act 2007 <sup>M1</sup>, and section 8(3) of the Welfare Reform Act 2009 <sup>M2</sup>, a draft of this instrument was laid before Parliament and approved by a resolution of each House of Parliament.

The Secretary of State for Work and Pensions makes the following Regulations in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 9 and 10 of the Social Security Act 1998 <sup>M3</sup>, and sections 11, 12(1) and (2), 13, 14, 15 <sup>M4</sup>, 16, 17(3)(b), 24(1) <sup>M5</sup> and 25 of the Welfare Reform Act 2007.

In accordance with section 173(1) of the Social Security Administration Act 1992 <sup>M6</sup>, the Secretary of State has obtained the agreement of the Social Security Advisory Committee that proposals in respect of these Regulations should not be referred to them.
