The Bribery Act 2010 (Consequential Amendments) Order 2011

The Secretary of State makes the following Order in exercise of the powers conferred by section 17(4) of the Bribery Act 2010⁽¹⁾.

(1) 2010 c. 23. Section 17(4) of the Bribery Act 2010 confers a power on the relevant national authority to make such supplementary, incidental or consequential provision for the purposes of the Act or in consequence of the Act; section 17(10) defines “relevant national authority”. The Secretary of State is the relevant national authority in relation to the provision made in this Order. The Order amends only secondary legislation, and is subject, therefore, by section 17(7) of the Act, to the negative procedure.
