ROAD TRAFFIC

**The A14 Trunk Road (Junction 38 Waterhall Interchange,
Newmarket, Suffolk) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order
2011**

Made - - - - *10th October 2011*

Coming into force - - *17th October 2011*

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A14 Trunk Road (“the A14”) and connecting roads, is satisfied that traffic on one of those connecting roads in the County of Suffolk should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984^(a) hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the A14 Trunk Road (Junction 38 Waterhall Interchange, Newmarket, Suffolk) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2011 and shall come into force on 17th October 2011.

2. In this Order –

“the link road” means the length of A14 which links the A1304 Highbury Road and the northbound carriageway of the A11 (known as Plantation Viaduct);

“works” mean the replacement and repair of bridge expansion joints to Plantation Viaduct;

“a works period” means a period of 10 hours starting at 20.00 hours on Thursday 20th October 2011 or on any subsequent day (other than a Saturday or a Sunday) until the works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 4 no person shall, during a works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter –

(a) or proceed in the link road, or

(b) the link road at its junction with the A1304 Highbury Road.

4. The provisions of article 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall, from time to time, be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to a vehicle–

(a) being used for or in connection with the works, or for winter service maintenance,

(b) being used for, police, fire and rescue authority ambulance or traffic officer purposes,

- (c) proceeding at the direction or with the permission of a police constable, or a traffic officer in uniform, or
- (d) requiring access to the property which is accessible from, and only from, the link road.
