# **CUSTOMS**

The Postal Packets (Revenue and Customs) Regulations 2011

Made - - - - 19th December 2011

The Treasury, in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 105(2) and 122 of the Postal Services Act 2000 MI, and on the recommendation of the Commissioners for Her Majesty's Revenue and Customs M2 and the Secretary of State, make the following Regulations.
