The Hull and Goole Port Health Authority Order 2011

Expenses

10.—(1) Any expenses incurred by the joint board shall be defrayed out of a common fund to be contributed to by the specified riparian authorities in the following proportions—

Kingston upon Hull City Council	65%
East Riding of Yorkshire Council	12.75%
North Lincolnshire Council	22.25%

(2) The contributions set out in paragraph (1) may be varied with the agreement of all three specified riparian authorities.

- (3) Paragraph (4) applies where—
 - (a) one or more of the specified riparian authorities seeks to vary the contributions but an agreement cannot be reached;
 - (b) five years have elapsed since this Order was made; and
 - (c) the contributions have not been varied for five years or more.

(4) A single arbitrator agreed upon by the specified riparian authorities (or in default of agreement a person nominated by the President of the Chartered Institute of Arbitrators for the time being) may determine the contribution of each specified riparian authority.
