



“the works periods” means three weekends as follows:

- i. starting at 2200 hours on Saturday 15 September 2012 and ending at 1600 hours on Sunday 16 September 2012;
- ii. starting at 2200 hours on Saturday 22 September 2012 and ending at 1600 hours on Sunday 23 September 2012; and
- iii. starting at 2200 hours on Saturday 29 September 2012 and ending at 1600 hours on Sunday 30 September 2012. However, work may start and continue beyond these dates for such period not exceeding 18 months as shall be required to complete the work;

“works” means concrete removal works on the Dykelands and Red Syke Bridges on the trunk road;

**3.** Subject as mentioned in article 5 of this Order, during the works period, no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the layby to be closed.

**4.** Subject as mentioned in article 5 of this Order, during the works period, no person shall cause or permit any bus to enter or proceed in the bus stop area within the layby to be closed.

**5.** The provisions of article 3 and 4 of this Order shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs, and shall not apply to a vehicle being used for emergency purposes by the police, fire and rescue authority or ambulance services or anything done at the direction, or with the permission, of a constable, or a traffic officer in uniform.
