Enactments Applying to Part 2 Panels

1. Part VA of, and Schedule 12A to, the Local Government Act 1972 ^{M1} (access to meetings and documents of certain authorities, committees and sub-committees).

They apply to a local authority, a committee established under section 102 of the Local Government Act 1972 and a joint committee which is appointed or established under any other enactment and is not a body corporate by virtue of sections 100E and 270(1).
